



Colonel Steichen was commissioned in the United States Army in 2000 as an Ordnance Officer and later became a Multifunctional Logistician. Colonel Steichen served multiple tours in the Republic of South Korea as a Ground Support Electronics Platoon Leader, Maintenance Control Officer, Support Operations Maintenance Officer, Ordnance Company Commander, Munitions Branch Chief, and Materiel Readiness Branch Chief.

COL Steichen later became a Functional Area-57 (FA57) Simulations Operations Officer and then served tours in Germany and Norway, in addition to multiple locations in the United States. COL Steichen deployed to Afghanistan and to the United Arab Emirates, serving as Deputy Director Combined Joint Operations Center and United States Army Central Liaison Officer.

COL Steichen served as Chief Knowledge Officer, Battle Command Integration Officer, Deputy Chief Future Operations, Deputy Brigade Commander, and now currently serves as the Division Head Exercise Production for the NATO Joint Warfare Centre in Stavanger Norway. The Exercise Production Division supports NATO Computer Assisted Exercises (CAX) from the planning through execution with the four branches which are the CAX, Content, OPFOR, and Scenario branches. Additionally, the Exercise Production Division supports other NATO exercises such as COBALT, CWIX, and Crisis Response.
