



Dr. Belanger is an assistant professor at the Institute for Military Operations at the Royal Danish Defence College with expertise in the fields of Wargaming, Decision-Making, Deterrence, and Multi-Domain Operations.

His current research projects use wargaming as a data generating tool to study the causes of nuclear escalation, the deterrent effect of integrated air power, the effect of sleep on decision-making, Russian naval strategy in the Mediterranean, and NATO's MDO concept.

He's a Senior Non-Resident Associate Fellow at the NATO Defense College and a Non-Resident Senior Fellow at the Cornell University Brooks Tech Policy Institute. He was previously a postdoctoral researcher at the Balsillie School of International Affairs at the University of Waterloo (2020-2023), and at the International Security Studies at Yale University (2018-2020).

A Canadian national, Jean-François holds a PhD in Political Science from McGill University, an MA in Political Science from Dalhousie University, and an honor's degree in Political Science from Concordia University.
